

## Rolls-Royce Regional Training Center Agreement Off-site Supplemental Terms and Conditions

For Training Services that are provided off-site at the Customer's facility, at a location of an owner or operator ("Operator") for whom the Customer provides services, or otherwise away from the RCTC or designated Rolls-Royce training facility, the following terms shall be made a part of the Rolls-Royce Regional Training Center Agreement:

17. **Materials:** Training Materials will be provided by Rolls-Royce.
18. **Classroom:** Customer agrees to provide, or ensure that the Operator provides, a classroom suitable for any lectures with amenities suitable for student participation, including chairs, desks/tables, projection screen, audio/visual equipment, adequate lighting, and ventilation to foster an acceptable learning environment.
19. **Computer projector:** Customer agrees to provide, or ensure that the Operator provides, an LCD (or similar) projector and required cables for attachment to the training instructor's presentation computer.
20. **Engine laboratory:** Customer agrees to provide, or ensure that the Operator provides, an engine laboratory environment suitable for hands-on engine maintenance, including but not limited to component/LRU removal/installation and inspection, in reasonable proximity to the classroom. An electrical power source is also to be available for computing, lighting, and inspection equipment.
21. **Engine Tooling and Equipment:** Customer agrees to provide, or ensure that the Operator provides, all tooling, equipment, and consumables, including special tooling as outlined in the Engine and Maintenance Manuals, to conduct the requested training. A list of tooling, equipment, and consumables needed to conduct the Training Services will be provided by RCTC for customer verification prior to finalizing training arrangements. If such tooling, equipment, and consumables cannot be provided by the Customer or the Operator, RCTC can provide the items required for the Training Services. The Customer will incur additional cost for shipping and import/export fees.
22. **Engine Training Aids:** Unless agreed otherwise, Rolls-Royce will make reasonable efforts to provide an engine training asset in advance of provision of the Training Services. If an Operator engine is used, Appendix 2 – indemnification, must first be executed.
23. **Course Language:** Course is to be taught by Rolls-Royce personnel in the English language. The Customer agrees to supply, or ensure that the Operator supplies, a competent technical translator for the group during each instructional session. If the translator is also a Student participating in the Training Services, he/she will receive Training Services without tuition charge.
24. **Indemnification:** If the Operator is providing an engine for the purpose of Training Services, it is agreed by the Customer and Rolls-Royce that this engine training asset is a non-serviceable training engine. At the completion of Training Services, the Operator must:
  - a. undertake, at its expense, all necessary inspection actions;
  - b. not return the engine to service unless and until the Operator, at its expense, conducts appropriate maintenance through either the Customer or an authorized shop; and
  - c. certify that the engine is airworthy (or serviceable for non-aircraft applications) at the completion of the Training Services on the engine and complete all required release documentation.

The Customer agrees to release, indemnify, and hold harmless Rolls-Royce in the event that any of the above undertakings by the Operator do not occur.

Rolls-Royce is not responsible for returning the training engine, component or LRU to a serviceable condition.

Rolls-Royce is not responsible for replacement or repair of components damaged during the conduct of the Training Services.
