## Line and Base Maintenance

### Course syllabus

Training level ATA 104 Level III

---

**Target population** Licensed/non-licensed engineers, responsible for supervising/performing routine and non-routine maintenance and troubleshooting tasks.

---

**General description** On completion of the course each student will be able to; describe, identify and locate line replaceable units (LRUs), describe systems and LRUs operation, service the engine and undertake non-routine maintenance, remove and install LRUs (including rigging), identify all warnings and cautions associated with working on the engine on wing and inspect, check, troubleshoot and conduct system tests.

---

**Notes** Students will be qualified engineers experienced and probably licensed in aircraft maintenance. They will be competent in the application of engine maintenance standard practices in accordance with ATA Chapter 70-00-00 engine/aircraft maintenance manuals. Operation knowledge and maintenance familiarisation of medium bypass engines is desirable but not essential.
