Course syllabus

Training level ATA 104 Level III

Target population Licensed and non-licensed engineers, responsible for supervising/performing routine and non-routine maintenance and troubleshooting tasks

General description On completion of the course each student will be able to; describe, identify and locate line replaceable units (LRUs), describe systems and LRUs operation, service the engine and undertake non-routine maintenance, remove and install LRUs (including rigging), identify all warnings and cautions associated with working on the engine on wing, inspect, check, troubleshoot and conduct system tests.

Notes Students will be qualified engineers, experienced and probably licensed in aircraft maintenance. They will be competent in the application of engine maintenance standard practices in accordance with ATA Chapter 70-00-00 engine/aircraft maintenance manuals. Operation knowledge and maintenance familiarisation of medium bypass engines is desirable but not essential.
